Applicants will be required to provide evidence that you have completed all your seagoing service and be in a position to apply for your Notice of Eligibility (NOE). **Please note that you do NOT need to have completed all your courses before applying for your NOE.**

You should only submit an application when you are ready to commence your studies and must be within six months after award offer. It is a requirement that all applicants (except ETOs) irrespective of previous learning complete the Marine Society Online Maths and Writing Up-Skilling Programmes before submitting an application.
